

Registration Guide 2022

This information sheet provides important information to help you with the 2022 registration process

• The MyNetball system in which registrations used to occur has been decommissioned. The replacement system is *PlayHQ*. This means things look very different to previous years. Most significantly, if you are playing and already have a team, you must register as a <u>participant to team</u> using a link provided to you by your Team Primary Contact. To enable that, your Team Primary Contact must first register your <u>team to season</u> via the appropriate one of the links shown below:

- Unless you have already used *PlayHQ* for participation in another sport, you will need to create a new personal profile in *PlayHQ* either prior to registering or during the registration process. There are strong recommendations within the *PlayHQ* community that parents create their own account and register their children under that. All registrations must be completed online using the *PlayHQ* system. No alternative options exist.
- If you are a Netball player who is looking for a place in a team, have a look at the MNA Facebook page for guidance. If you are a Set player who is looking for a place in a team, have a look at the MNA Facebook page for guidance or simply register as an individual and MNA will attempt to find a team for you. If you are a Net player, simply register as an individual
- If you are eligible for a NSW Government Active Kids Voucher and intend to use it when registering, you should make sure you redeem it prior to registering. Go to: https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-active-kids-voucher
- If you experience difficulties with your registration, in the first instance seek assistance from your Team Primary Contact or from other people associated with your team. If that fails, then seek assistance from MNA.
- Registrations open well before the netball season starts. Any difficulties should be addressed at the first available
 opportunity. If you arrive on a Saturday morning hoping to fix any registration difficulties and then play or officiate
 that same day, you may be severely disappointed.
